#### **Residency Programs:**

 Programs: Include family and internal medicine residencies across Tulare, Hanford, Sonora, and Bakersfield. Some of the achievements include the inaugural class of the Tulare Family Medicine Residency graduated in 2024, with most graduates remaining in the Central Valley to serve local communities.

Some of the community needs and challenges include high rates of poverty and significant reliance on Medi-Cal and Medicare (over 60% of payer sources in Tulare/Kings counties).

The health outcomes in the central valley are very poor. Concerns highlighted in the 2022 Community Health Needs Assessment included financial stability, access to care, and transportation. 76% of the community indicated financial stability as the main concern. Mobile Care Clinic:

- This allows AH to bring healthcare directly to the underserved populations in the Central Valley, regardless of insurance status.
- Some services include routine medical care, point-of-care testing, and vaccinations. They also provide referrals and connect them with specialists when needed. (Further details, see Presentation).
